1	AN ACT relating to firearms.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 527 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) A person is guilty of unlawful storage of a firearm when:
6	(a) He or she recklessly stores or leaves a firearm in a manner which allows a
7	minor to have unsupervised access to a firearm that is not secured by:
8	<u>1. A securely locked container;</u>
9	2. A device or mechanism, other than the firearm safety, designed to
10	render the firearm temporarily inoperable; or
11	3. Carrying the firearm on his or her body; and
12	(b) A minor, without permission of the minor's parent or guardian, accesses
13	<u>the firearm.</u>
14	(2) Unlawful storage of a firearm is a Class B misdemeanor, unless the minor,
15	without legal justification, uses the firearm in a manner which results in physical
16	injury, serious physical injury, or death to the minor or another person, in which
17	<u>case it is a Class A misdemeanor.</u>
18	(3) This section does not apply when the minor obtains the firearm as a result of
19	<u>unlawful means.</u>
20	Section 2. The restrictions of KRS $6.945(1)$ shall not apply to Section 1 of this
21	Act.
