2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:95(M)(1) and (2) and R.S. 40:1379.3(B), relative to the illegal
3	carrying of weapons; to exempt certain persons from the crime of illegal carrying of
4	weapons; to provide relative to concealed handgun permits; to provide relative to the
5	authority of a person to carry a concealed handgun without a permit; and to provide
6	for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. $14:95(M)(1)$ and (2) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
9	follows:
10	§95. Illegal carrying of weapons
11	* * *
12	M. The provisions of Paragraph $(A)(1)$ of this Section shall not apply to a
13	resident of Louisiana if all of the following conditions are met:
14	(1) The person is twenty-one <u>eighteen</u> years of age or older.
15	(2) The person is not prohibited from possessing a firearm under R.S.
16	14:95.1 , R.S. 40:1379.3(C)(5) through (17), 18 U.S.C. 922(g), or any other state or

1	Section 2. R.S. 40:1379.3(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
2	§1379.3. Statewide permits for concealed handguns; application procedures;
3	definitions

5	B.(1) A concealed handgun permit shall be issued only to a Louisiana
6	resident who qualifies for a permit under the provisions of this Section. A concealed
7	handgun permit issued pursuant to the provisions of this Section shall grant authority
8	to a Louisiana resident to carry a concealed handgun on his person.
9	(2)(a) A Louisiana resident who meets the qualifications of R.S. 14:95(M)
10	shall not be required to possess a valid concealed handgun permit issued by the state
11	of Louisiana pursuant to the provisions of this Section in order to carry a concealed
12	handgun in the state of Louisiana. The provisions of this Paragraph shall not affect
13	the requirements of reciprocity as provided in Subsection T of this Section.
14	(b) Any person carrying a concealed firearm pursuant to this Paragraph shall
15	be deemed to have certified that he meets all of the conditions required in R.S.
16	14:95(M).

Abstract: Exempts certain persons from the crime of illegal carrying of weapons and removes the requirement that a person possess a permit issued by the state of La. in order to carry a concealed handgun in the state of La.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 14:95) prohibits the carrying of a concealed firearm, provides for criminal penalties, and provides for certain exceptions to the offense.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> to create an exception to this prohibition for a person who is 18 years of age or older and who is not prohibited from possessing a firearm under any federal or state law.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 40:1379.3) provides that La. residents who meet certain eligibility requirements may apply for and be issued a concealed handgun permit authorizing the person to carry a concealed handgun on his person in the state of La. Further requires the

person to possess a valid concealed handgun permit issued by the state of La. in order to carry a concealed handgun in the state of La.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the requirement that a person possess a permit issued by the state of La. in order to carry a concealed handgun in the state of La.
