

1 WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the laws regarding "stand your ground" be
2 reviewed in comparison to the laws of other states and with respect to court decisions
3 interpreting those laws.

4 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
5 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby direct the Louisiana State Law Institute to evaluate the
6 provisions of Louisiana law regarding "stand your ground" provisions, as well as the
7 provisions of law from other states regarding this issue, and make any recommendations
8 regarding any changes to those laws which may result from that evaluation.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
10 director of the Louisiana State Law Institute.
