AMENDMENT NO. 1

14	A. Second degree murder is the killing of a human being <b>under any of the</b>
15	following circumstances:
16	(1) When the offender has a specific intent to kill or to inflict great bodily
17	harm <del>; or <u>.</u></del>
18	(2) When the offender is engaged in the perpetration or attempted
19	perpetration of aggravated or first degree rape, forcible or second degree rape,
20	aggravated arson, aggravated burglary, aggravated kidnapping, second degree
21	kidnapping, aggravated escape, assault by drive-by shooting, armed robbery, first
22	degree robbery, second degree robbery, simple robbery, cruelty to juveniles, second
23	degree cruelty to juveniles, or terrorism, even though he has no intent to kill or to
24	inflict great bodily harm.
25	(3)(a) When the offender unlawfully distributes or dispenses a controlled
26	dangerous substance listed in Schedules I through V of the Uniform Controlled
27	Dangerous Substances Law, or any combination thereof, except fentanyl or a
28	mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl or its
29	analogues, or carfentanil or a mixture or substance containing a detectable
30	amount of carfentanil or its analogues, which is the direct cause of the death of the
31	recipient who ingested or consumed the controlled dangerous substance.
32	(b) Whoever commits the crime of second degree murder defined in
33	Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall be punished by life imprisonment at
34	hard labor, at least twenty-five years of which shall be served without benefit
35	of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.
36	(3)(a) When the offender unlawfully distributes or dispenses fentanyl or
37	a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl or its
38	analogues, or carfentanil or a mixture or substance containing a detectable
39	amount of carfentanil or its analogues, which is the direct cause of the death of
40	the recipient who ingested or consumed the controlled dangerous substance.
41	(b) Whoever commits the crime of second degree murder defined in
42	Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall be punished by life imprisonment at
43	hard labor without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.
44	(4)(a) When the offender unlawfully distributes or dispenses a controlled
45	dangerous substance listed in Schedules I through V of the Uniform Controlled
46	Dangerous Substances Law, or any combination thereof, except fentanyl or a
47	mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl or its
48	analogues, or carfentanil or a mixture or substance containing a detectable
49	<b>amount of carfentanil or its analogues,</b> to another who subsequently distributes or
50	dispenses such controlled dangerous substance which is the direct cause of the death
51	of the person who ingested or consumed the controlled dangerous substance.

(b) Whoever commits the crime of second degree murder defined in	
Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall be punished by life imprisonment at	
hard labor, at least twenty-five years of which shall be served without benefit	
of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.	

(5)(a) When the offender unlawfully distributes or dispenses fentanyl or a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl or its analogues, or carfentanil or a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of carfentanil or its analogues, to another who subsequently distributes or dispenses such controlled dangerous substance which is the direct cause of the death of the person who ingested or consumed the controlled dangerous substance.

(b) Whoever commits the crime of second degree murder defined in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall be punished by life imprisonment at hard labor without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.

B. <u>Except as otherwise provided in this Section, whoever</u> Whoever commits the crime of second degree murder shall be punished by life imprisonment at hard labor without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence. **§30.2. Felony murder** 

Felony murder is the killing of a human being under either of the following circumstances:

(1)(a) When the offender is engaged in the perpetration or attempted perpetration of aggravated or first degree rape or forcible or second degree rape, even though he has no intent to kill or to inflict great bodily harm.

(b) Whoever commits the crime of second degree murder defined in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall be punished by life imprisonment at hard labor without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.

(2)(a)When the offender is engaged in the perpetration or attempted perpetration of aggravated arson, aggravated burglary, aggravated kidnapping, second degree kidnapping, aggravated escape, assault by drive-by shooting, armed robbery, first degree robbery, second degree robbery, simple robbery, cruelty to juveniles, second degree cruelty to juveniles, or terrorism, even though he has no intent to kill or to inflict great bodily harm.

33(b) Whoever commits the crime of second degree murder defined in34Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall be punished by life imprisonment at35hard labor at least twenty-five years of which shall be served without benefit of36parole, probation, or suspension of sentence."
