An Act relative to youth hunting programs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 129B of Chapter 140 shall be amended by deleting subparagraph 2 (v) of paragraph (1) and inserting in its place the following: (v) is at the time of the application 3 less than 14 years of age; providing said card shall not be issued until the applicant reaches the 4 age of 15.

5 SECTION 2. Section 129B of Chapter 140 shall be amended by deleting in subparagraph 6 (vi) of paragraph (1) the following: "at the time of the application more than 15 but"
