An Act relative to a report of firearms statistics.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 18 ¾ of chapter 6A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby further amended by adding the following clause:—
- 3 (10) to develop a biennial report to be sent to the clerks of the house and senate, the
- 4 house and senate committees on ways and means, the joint committee on public safety and
- 5 homeland security, and the joint committee on criminal justice on March 1 of every other year
- 6 beginning in 2012. Said report shall contain, but not be limited to, comprehensive information
- 7 and statistics related to firearms crimes and arrests and prosecutions of firearms-related offenses,
- 8 to serve as an examination of the effectiveness of the commonwealth's firearms-related
- 9 regulations. Said report shall include, but not be limited to, an explanation of substantial changes
- 10 in state and federal firearms-related laws and firearms-related statistics in the commonwealth.
