An Act relative to firearm license disqualifiers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 129B of Chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as
2	appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, shall be amended by inserting after the word "applicant"
3	in line 8 the following: - "is a prohibited person as defined in the following subparagraphs (i)
4	through (ix). When determining the status of a prohibited person in regards to convictions, the
5	determination shall only be made using the penalties and sentences in place at the time of
6	conviction."

8	□ SECTION 2. Section 131 of Chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in
9	the 2010 Official Edition, shall be amended by inserting after the word "applicant" in line 109
10	the following: - "is a prohibited person as defined in the following subparagraphs (i) through
11	(vii). When determining the status of a prohibited person in regards to convictions, the
12	determination shall only be made using the penalties and sentences in place at the time of
13	conviction."
