An Act relative to suppressors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	S	Section	n 10A of Chapter 269 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by	
2	deleting	the se	ection in its entirety and inserting in its place the following:

4	I	Any person found to be in possession of a firearm suppressor who is:		
5	((a)	a prohibited person under section 131 of chapter 140;	
6	((b)	in the commission of a violent crime or felony;	
7	((c)	in the commission of a crime of violence against a family member;	
8	((d)	conducting sales or has possession of controlled substances as defined in chapter	
9	94C;

shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than ten years in state prison or for notmore than two and one-half years in a jail or house of correction.

For the purposes of this section the term "firearm suppressor" shall have the same meaning as Federal law 18 USC 921(24): The terms "firearm suppressor" mean any device for silencing, muffling, or diminishing the report of a portable firearm, including any combination of parts, designed or redesigned, and intended for use in assembling or fabricating a firearm silencer or firearm muffler, and any part intended only for use in such assembly or fabrication.
