#### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to stun guns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 131J of Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
- 2 Section 2. Section 121 of Chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 3 Edition of the General Laws, is hereby amended by amending the definition of the word
- 4 "firearm" in line 47 by adding the following language after the word "manufactured":-
- 5 ",or a portable device or weapon from which an electrical current, impulse, wave or beam
- 6 may be directed, which current, impulse, wave or beam is designed to incapacitate temporarily,
- 7 injure or kill".
