Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 123 of Chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting a new paragraph:
- 3 "Notwithstanding any general law, special law, or regulation to the contrary, firearms
- 4 furnished through the Civilian Marksmanship Program as established by the United States
- 5 Congress shall be eligible for transfer by a licensee."
