### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to firearm reporting procedures.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 122 of chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
- 2 following paragraph:-
- 3 Every person licensed to sell, rent or lease firearms shall, for each firearm, contact the
- 4 Massachusetts State Police Crime Laboratory Ballistics Section to test-fire the firearm,
- 5 photograph the firearm and prepare ballistics reports based upon their examination to be
- 6 submitted to along with the make, model, serial number, caliber, barrel length, and gun surface
- 7 finish for the gun transaction to the Massachusetts Instant Record Check System and Firearm
- 8 Records Bureau. After the gun information has been entered, every licensed person shall contact
- 9 the National Instant Criminal Background Check System.
