In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act to increase penalties for shooting a firearm while on release.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 of the acts of 2018, is hereby further amended by inserting the following paragraph after 10 (o):

3 (p) Whoever discharges a weapon of which violates any provision found within section

4 10 of chapter 269, while that person is on release pursuant to sections 42A, 57, 58, 58A, 58B, 87

5 of chapter 276 or section 3A of chapter 211F, shall be further punished by imprisonment in a jail

6 or house of correction for not more than two and one-half years or for not more than five years in

7 state prison.
