# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act establishing a self-defense exception.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Subsection A of section 99 of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as
2	appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence in
3	the third paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:-
4	Therefore, the secret use of such devices by private individuals must be prohibited,
5	unless each of the following is true: (1) the individual is a party to the encounter that they are
6	surveilling; (2) the individual is not employed by a law enforcement entity, nor acting under the
7	auspices of one; and (3) the individual has a reasonable fear that the other party intends to
8	physically harm them, another person, or themselves.
