2 sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of House documents
3 numbered 2382 and 2392, relative to firearms and firearm dealer licensing.

5 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
6 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
7 on or before December 31, 2024.
