An Act relative to the town of Foxborough.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 5 of the Acts of 2004 is hereby amended by striking out Section 3(a) and  
2 inserting in place thereof the following section:-

3 Section 3(a) The executive powers of the town shall be vested in the board of selectmen,  
4 in this act referred to as BOS, who shall have all powers given to boards of selectmen by the  
5 General Laws, except for those executive powers granted to the town manager and except for  
6 those executive powers granted to the town's board of water and sewer commissioners by  
7 Chapter 46 of the Acts of 1986, provided, however, that all personnel and collective bargaining  
8 powers of the water and sewer commissioners shall be vested with the town manager, and  
9 provided further, however, that any sale of sewer capacity outside the Town borders shall be  
10 subject to the joint approval of the BOS and Water & Sewer Commissioners.
