Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 609.67, subdivision 1, is amended to read: 1.6 Subdivision 1. **Definitions.** (a) "Machine gun" means any firearm designed to discharge, 1.7 or capable of discharging automatically more than once by a single function of the trigger. 1.8 (b) "Shotgun" means a weapon designed, redesigned, made or remade which is intended 1.9 to be fired from the shoulder and uses the energy of the explosive in a fixed shotgun shell 1.10 to fire through a smooth bore either a number of ball shot or a single projectile for each 1.11 1.12 single pull of the trigger. (c) "Short-barreled shotgun" means a shotgun having one or more barrels less than 18 1.13 1.14 inches in length and any weapon made from a shotgun if such weapon as modified has an overall length less than 26 inches. 1.15 (d) "Trigger activator" means a removable manual or power driven trigger activating 1 16 device constructed and designed so that, when attached to a firearm, the rate at which the 1.17 trigger may be pulled increases and the rate of fire of the firearm increases to approximate 1.18 that of a machine gun. (e) "Machine gun conversion kit" means any part or combination of parts designed and 1.22 intended for use in converting a weapon into a machine gun, and any combination of parts 1 23

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from which a machine gun can be assembled, but does not include a spare or replacement

part for a machine gun that is possessed lawfully under section 609.67, subdivision 3.
