2 Page 4, Line 48, by deleting said line and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 568.075. 1. A person commits the offense of use of a minor to commit a crime if the person  
6 is eighteen years of age or older and intentionally uses a minor to commit a crime for which the  
7 person may be prosecuted in a court of law or to assist in avoiding detection of or apprehension for  
8 such crime.

9 2. Any person found guilty of a violation of subsection 1 of this section shall:

10 (1) For the first violation, be subject to twice the maximum term of imprisonment and twice  
11 the maximum fine, if applicable, that would otherwise be authorized for the crime; and

12 (2) For a second or subsequent violation, be subject to three times the maximum term of  
13 imprisonment and three times the maximum fine, if applicable, that would otherwise be authorized  
14 for the crime.

15 3. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

16 (1) "Minor", a person who is under eighteen years of age;

17 (2) "Use", employ, hire, persuade, induce, entice, or coerce."; and"; and
