AN ACT

To repeal sections 571.121 and 571.230, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to concealed carry permits.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 571.121 and 571.230, RSMo, are repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be

3 known as sections 571.121 and 571.230, to read as follows:

571.121. 1. Any person issued a concealed carry

2 permit pursuant to sections 571.101 to 571.121, or a

3 concealed carry endorsement issued prior to August 28, 2013,

4 shall carry the concealed carry permit or endorsement at all

5 times the person is carrying a concealed firearm and shall

6 display the concealed carry permit and a state or federal

7 government-issued photo identification or the endorsement or

8 permit upon the request of any peace officer. Carrying and

9 display of a concealed carry permit or endorsement as

10 required under this subsection may be accomplished by the

11 carrying and display of a digital copy of such concealed

12 carry permit or endorsement, which includes but is not

13 limited to a personal photograph of the permit or

14 endorsement stored digitally on an electronic device.

15 Failure to comply with this subsection shall not be a

16 criminal offense but the concealed carry permit or

17 endorsement holder may be issued a citation for an amount
18 not to exceed thirty-five dollars.

- 2. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the director of revenue, by carrying out his or her requirement to issue a driver's or nondriver's license reflecting that a concealed carry permit has been granted under the law as it existed prior to August 28, 2013, shall bear no liability and shall be immune from any claims for damages resulting from any determination made regarding the qualification of any person for such permit or for any actions stemming from the conduct of any person issued such a permit. By issuing the permit on the driver's or nondriver's license, the director of revenue was merely acting as a scrivener for any determination made by the sheriff that the person was qualified for the permit.
- 571.230. Any person issued a Missouri lifetime or 2 extended concealed carry permit under sections 571.205 to 3 571.230, shall carry the permit at all times the person is 4 carrying a concealed firearm and shall display the permit and a state or federal government-issued photo 5 6 identification upon the request of any peace officer. 7 Carrying and display of a permit as required under this 8 subsection may be accomplished by the carrying and display 9 of a digital copy of such permit, which includes but is not 10 limited to a personal photograph of the permit stored 11 digitally on an electronic device. Failure to comply with this section shall not be a criminal offense but the 12 13 Missouri lifetime or extended concealed carry permit holder 14 may be issued a citation for an amount not to exceed thirty-15 five dollars.
