## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 638**

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Concealed Handgun Permit Act; to amend
2	section 69-2434, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section
3	69-2436, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to change
4	permit expiration provisions for members of the armed forces or
5	their spouses as prescribed; and to repeal the original sections.
6	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 69-2434, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 69-2434 The design and form of the permit to carry a concealed 4 handgun shall be prescribed by the Nebraska State Patrol. The permit 5 shall list the permitholder's name, the permitholder's address, and the 6 expiration date <u>or explanation of the expiration date</u> of the permit and 7 contain a photograph of the permitholder.

8 Sec. 2. Section 69-2436, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,9 2014, is amended to read:

10 69-2436 (1) <u>Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a</u> 11 A permit to carry a concealed handgun is valid throughout the state for a 12 period of five years after the date of issuance. The fee for issuing a 13 permit is one hundred dollars.

14 (2) If a permitholder, or a permitholder's spouse, is a member of 15 the armed forces of the United States or National Guard, the permit to 16 carry a concealed handgun shall be valid throughout the state as provided 17 in subsection (1) of this section or the period of time the permitholder, 18 or the permitholder's spouse, is on active duty with the armed forces of 19 the United States or National Guard, whichever is longer. In no case 20 shall the permit be valid for more than ten years.

(<u>3</u> 2) The Nebraska State Patrol shall renew a person's permit to carry a concealed handgun for a renewal period of five years, <u>or the</u> period as provided in subsection (2) of this section, subject to continuing compliance with the requirements of section 69-2433, except as provided in subsection (4) of section 69-2443. The renewal fee is fifty dollars, and renewal may be applied for up to four months before expiration of a permit to carry a concealed handgun.

(<u>4</u> <del>3</del>) The applicant shall submit the fee with the application to the
Nebraska State Patrol. The fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer
for credit to the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund.

31 (5 4) On or before June 30, 2007, the Nebraska State Patrol shall

journal entry, as necessary, all current fiscal year expenses and
 revenue, including investment income, from the Public Safety Cash Fund
