1 Section 1. Section 69-2436, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 69-2436 (1) A permit to carry a concealed handgun is valid
- 4 throughout the state for a period of five years after the date of
- 5 issuance. The fee for issuing a permit is one hundred dollars.
- 6 (2) The Nebraska State Patrol shall renew a <u>permitholder's</u> <u>person's</u>
- 7 permit to carry a concealed handgun for a renewal period of five years,
- 8 subject to continuing compliance with the requirements of section
- 9 69-2433, except as provided in subsection (4) of section 69-2443. The
- 10 renewal fee is fifty dollars, and renewal may be applied for no earlier
- 11 <u>than</u> <del>up to</del> four months before expiration of <u>the</u> <del>a</del> permit <u>and no later</u>
- 12 than thirty business days after the date of expiration of the permit to
- 13 carry a concealed handgun.
- 14 (3) The applicant shall submit the fee with the application to the
- 15 Nebraska State Patrol. The fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer
- 16 for credit to the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund.
- 17 (4) On or before June 30, 2007, the Nebraska State Patrol shall
- 18 journal entry, as necessary, all current fiscal year expenses and
- 19 revenue, including investment income, from the Public Safety Cash Fund
- 20 under the Concealed Handgun Permit Act and recode them against the
- 21 Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund and its program appropriation.
- 22 Sec. 2. Original section 69-2436, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 23 Nebraska, is repealed.
