## ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 491–COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

## MAY 30, 2015

## Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Authorizes and provides funding for certain projects of capital improvement. (BDR S-1289)

EXPLANATION - Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets *fomitted material* is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to projects of capital improvement; authorizing certain expenditures by the State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration; levying a property tax to support the Consolidated Bond Interest and Redemption Fund; making appropriations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration the sum of \$6,403,083 to support the Division in carrying out the program of capital improvements as summarized in this section. The amount is allocated to projects numbered and described in the Executive Budget for the 2015-2017 biennium or otherwise described as follows:

**Sec. 4.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by 23 24 section 3 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after 25 June 30, 2019, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or 26 27 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose 28 29 after September 20, 2019, by either the entity to which the money 30 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently 31 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before September 20, 2019. 32

**Sec. 5.** The amounts appropriated pursuant to section 3 of this act from the State Highway Fund must be allocated by the State Controller as the money is required for the projects and must not be transferred to the projects from the State Highway Fund until required to make contract payments.

**Sec. 6.** The State Board of Finance shall issue general obligation bonds of the State of Nevada in the face amount of not more than \$98,500,000 for the capital improvements summarized in this subsection. The amount is allocated to projects numbered and identified in the Executive Budget for the 2015-2017 biennium or otherwise described as follows:

 subsection.

5 The State Board of Finance shall not issue the bonds 2 6 described in subsection 1 unless the Board determines that the money budgeted or to be budgeted pursuant to subsection 3 will be 7 8 sufficient to pay the bond repayment costs of the bonds authorized 9 by subsection 1. In making its determination under this subsection, 10 the State Board of Finance shall be entitled to rely on a certification of the Director of the Office of Finance in the Office of the 11 12 Governor that the money budgeted and to be budgeted pursuant to 13 subsection 3 will be sufficient to pay the bond repayment costs of 14 the bonds authorized by subsection 1. Any determination by the 15 State Board of Finance under this subsection shall be conclusive. As used in this subsection, "bond repayment costs" means the principal 16 17 of and interest on the bonds and any other costs related to the payment of the bonds or compliance with covenants made in 18 19 connection with those bonds, as estimated by the State Treasurer.

The Legislature intends that 12.5 percent of the annual bond 20 3. 21 repayment costs of the bonds authorized by subsection 1, and any 22 bonds directly or indirectly, through a series of refundings, refunding those bonds, will be paid from the Pollution Control 23 Account created by NRS 445B.830, and 87.5 percent of those 24 25 annual bond repayment costs will be paid from annually available money in the State Highway Fund. The Director of the Office of 26 Finance in the Office of the Governor, the Director of the 27 28 Department of Transportation and the Director of the Department of 29 Motor Vehicles are hereby directed to budget for payment of such 30 bond repayment costs from the sources and in the proportions stated 31 in this subsection in each budget or other spending plan presented to 32 the Legislature for the expenditure of amounts in the Pollution 33 Control Account created by NRS 445B.830 and the State Highway Fund after the effective date of this section until the bonds 34 35 authorized by subsection 1 and any bonds directly or indirectly 36 refunding those bonds are no longer outstanding. The money so 37 budgeted to pay the annual bond repayment costs of the bonds 38 authorized by subsection 1, and any bonds directly or indirectly, 39 through a series of refundings, refunding those bonds, are hereby appropriated in each year to the Consolidated Bond Interest and 40 41 Redemption Fund to pay such bond repayment costs. As used in this subsection, "annually available money in the State Highway Fund" 42 means money remaining in the State Highway Fund in any year 43 44 after all amounts required to pay bonds issued pursuant to





1 NRS 408.273 in that year have been paid or provision for such 2 payment has been made.

3 Sec. 9. Any remaining balance of the allocated amounts 4 authorized in section 8 of this act must not be committed for 5 expenditure after June 30, 2019, and must be reverted to the Bond 6 Interest and Redemption Account in the Consolidated Bond Interest 7 and Redemption Fund on or before September 20, 2019.

8 Sec. 10. 1. The State Board of Finance may issue the bonds 9 authorized pursuant to sections 6 and 8 of this act at the time 10 deemed appropriate by the Board based on the schedule established 11 for the completion of the projects described in those sections.

12 The State Controller may advance temporarily from the 2. 13 State General Fund, upon the approval of the Director of the Office 14 of Finance in the Office of the Governor, to the State Public Works 15 Division of the Department of Administration, until the date on which the bonds authorized by section 6 of this act are sold, 16 17 amounts necessary to facilitate the start of the projects enumerated in section 6 of this act. The amounts temporarily advanced by the 18 19 State Controller shall be made as the money is required for the 20 projects and must not be transferred to the projects from the State 21 General Fund until required to make contract payments. The 22 advanced amounts must be repaid immediately to the State General 23 Fund upon the sale of the bonds or not later than the last business 24 day in August immediately following the end of the fiscal year 25 during which the advance is made.

The State Controller may advance temporarily from the 26 3. 27 State Highway Fund, upon the approval of the Director of the Office 28 of Finance in the Office of the Governor, to the State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration, until the date on 29 30 which the bonds authorized by section 8 of this act are sold, 31 amounts necessary to facilitate the start of the project enumerated in 32 section 8 of this act. The amounts temporarily advanced by the State 33 Controller must be made as the money is required for the project and must not be transferred to the project from the State Highway 34 Fund until required to make contract payments. The advanced 35 36 amounts must be repaid immediately to the State Highway Fund 37 upon the sale of the bonds or not later than the last business day in 38 August immediately following the end of the fiscal year during 39 which the advance is made.

40 4. The Director of the Office of Finance in the Office of the 41 Governor shall provide written notification to the State Controller, 42 the State Treasurer and the Senate and Assembly Fiscal Analysts of 43 the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau 44 of the approval of the advances from the State General Fund and the 45 State Highway Fund to the State Public Works Division pursuant to





1 subsections 2 and 3. The Director of the Office of Finance in the 2 Office of the Governor shall provide a reconciliation to the Senate and Assembly Fiscal Analysts of the Fiscal Analysis Division of 3 the Legislative Counsel Bureau of the advances authorized from the 4 5 State General Fund and State Highway Fund and repayments to the 6 State General Fund and the State Highway Fund made during any 7 fiscal year during the 2015-2017 biennium. The reconciliation must 8 be provided not later than the last business day in August 9 immediately following the end of the fiscal year during which the 10 advance is made.

Sec. 11. 1. 11 The State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration shall transfer the sum of \$530,842 12 13 from the amounts authorized pursuant to section 4 of chapter 398. 14 Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page 1547, as last amended by section 15 37 of chapter 445, Statutes of Nevada 2013, at page 2590, for the 16 project numbered and described in the Executive Budget for the 17 2005-2007 biennium or otherwise described as Project 05-C13, Las 18 Vegas Readiness Center for Nevada National Guard, to the project 19 as authorized in subsection 2.

20 2. The State Public Works Division of the Department of 21 Administration shall use the \$530,842 transferred pursuant to 22 subsection 1 to support the Division in carrying out the program of 23 capital improvement for the project numbered and described in the 24 Executive Budget for the 2015-2017 biennium or otherwise 25 described as Project 15-P02, Advance Planning, Nevada National 26 Guard Readiness Center in North Las Vegas.

**Sec. 12.** Any remaining balance of the amount transferred in section 11 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2019, and must be reverted to the Bond Interest and Redemption Account in the Consolidated Interest and Redemption Fund on or before September 20, 2019.

**Sec. 13.** 1. The State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration shall transfer the sum of \$47,132 from the amounts authorized pursuant to section 3 of chapter 347, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 1642, as last amended by section 38 of chapter 445, Statutes of Nevada 2013, at page 2591, from the projects identified in this subsection to the projects as authorized in subsections 2 and 3:
