AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Office of the Attorney General for projected extradition costs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
2 Fund to the Office of the Extradition Coordinator in the Office of
3 the Attorney General the sum of \$169,000 to replenish Fiscal Year
4 2014-2015 extradition funds used in 2014, and to supplement funds
5 for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 due to increased extradition costs. This
6 appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 4 of chapter
7 446, Statutes of Nevada 2013, at page 2593.
8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
