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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. Section 29-19-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
17	Chapter 255, Section 6, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"29-19-6. [APPEAL] <u>LICENSE ISSUANCE</u> LICENSE RENEWAL
19	REFRESHER FIREARMS TRAINING COURSELOST OR STOLEN LICENSE
20	SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF LICENSE
21	A. Pursuant to rules adopted by the department, the
22	department, within thirty days after receiving a completed
23	application for a concealed handgun license and the results of
24	a national criminal background check on the applicant and no
25	more than ninety days after receiving a completed application,
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2 (1)issue a concealed handgun license to an 3 applicant; or

4 deny the application on the grounds that (2) 5 the applicant failed to qualify for a concealed handgun license pursuant to the provisions of the Concealed Handgun Carry Act. 6

Β. Information relating to an applicant or to a 8 licensee received by the department or any other law enforcement agency is confidential and exempt from public 10 disclosure unless an order to disclose information is issued by 11 a court of competent jurisdiction. The information shall be 12 made available by the department to a state or local law 13 enforcement agency upon request by the agency.

C. A concealed handgun license issued by the department shall include:

> a color photograph of the licensee; (1)

the licensee's name, address and date (2) of birth:

(3) the expiration date of the concealed handgun license; and

the category and the largest caliber of (4) handgun that the licensee is licensed to carry, with a statement that the licensee is licensed to carry smaller caliber handguns but shall carry only one concealed handgun at any given time.

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D. A licensee shall notify the department within 2 thirty days regarding a change of the licensee's name or permanent address. A licensee shall notify the department within ten days if the licensee's concealed handgun license is lost, stolen or destroyed.

Ε. If a concealed handgun license is lost, stolen or destroyed, the license is invalid and the licensee may 8 obtain a duplicate license by furnishing the department a 9 notarized statement that the original license was lost, stolen 10 or destroyed and paying a reasonable fee. If the license is 11 lost or stolen, the licensee shall file a police report with a 12 local law enforcement agency and include the police case number 13 in the notarized statement.

A licensee may renew a concealed handgun license F. by submitting to the department:

a completed renewal form, under penalty of (1)perjury, designed and provided by the department;

(2) a payment of a seventy-five-dollar (\$75.00) renewal fee; and

a certificate of completion of a four-hour (3) refresher firearms training course approved by the department.

The department shall conduct a national criminal G. records check of a licensee seeking to renew a license. The department shall issue the renewal no more than sixty days after the submission of the materials pursuant to Subsection F .218935.2

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of this section. A concealed handgun license shall not be renewed more than sixty days after it has expired. A licensee who fails to renew a concealed handgun license within sixty days after it has expired may apply for a new concealed handgun license pursuant to the provisions of the Concealed Handgun Carry Act.

A licensee shall complete a two-hour refresher н. 8 firearms training course two years after the issuance of an 9 original or renewed license. The refresher course shall be 10 approved by the department and shall be taken twenty-two to 11 twenty-six months after the issuance of an original or renewed 12 license. A certificate of completion shall be submitted to the 13 department no later than thirty days after completion of the 14 course.

The department shall suspend or revoke a I. concealed handgun license if:

the licensee provided the department with (1)false information on the application form or renewal form for a concealed handgun license;

the licensee did not satisfy the criteria (2) for issuance of a concealed handgun license at the time the license was issued; or

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subsequent to receiving a concealed (3) handgun license, the licensee violated a provision of the Concealed Handgun Carry Act."

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
