5	The Gener	al Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
6		SECTION 1. This act shall be known as "The Religious Assembly Security and		
7	Protection	Act of 2021."		
8		<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 14-269.2(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:		
9		"(1c) School operating hours. – Any time when any of the following occur:		
10		<u>a.</u> <u>The premises are being used for curricular or extracurricular activities.</u>		
11		b. The premises are being used for educational, instructional, or		
12		school-sponsored activities.		
13		<u>c.</u> <u>The premises are being used for programs for minors by entities not</u>		
14		affiliated with the religious institution."		
15		<b>SECTION 3.</b> G.S. 14-269.2 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
16	" <u>(k1)</u>	For the purposes of this subsection, property owned by a local board of education or		
17		nmission shall not be construed as a building that is a place of religious worship as		
18		G.S. 14-54.1. The provisions of this section shall not apply to a person who has a		
19		handgun permit that is valid under Article 54B of this Chapter, or who is exempt from		
20	<u>obtaining a</u>	permit pursuant to that Article, if all of the following conditions apply:		
21 22		(1) The person possesses and carries a handgun on educational property other than		
22		an institution of higher education as defined by G.S. 116-143.1 or a nonpublic,		
23 24		postsecondary educational institution.		
24		(2) The educational property is the location of both a school and a building that is		
25		a place of religious worship as defined in G.S. 14-54.1.		
26		(3) The weapon is a handgun.		
27		(4) The handgun is only possessed and carried on educational property outside of		
28		the school operating hours.		
29		(5) The person or persons in legal possession or control of the premises have not		
30		posted a conspicuous notice prohibiting the carrying of a concealed handgun		
31		on the premises in accordance with G.S. 14-415.11(c)."		
32		SECTION 4. G.S. 14-415.11(c) reads as rewritten:		
33	"(c)	Except as provided in G.S. 14-415.27, a permit does not authorize a person to carry		
34	a conceale	d handgun in any of the following:
