A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CONCEALED CARRY OF BLADED WEAPONS IF CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS ARE MET.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 14-269 reads as rewritten:

"§ 14-269. Carrying concealed weapons.

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- (d) This section does not apply to an ordinary pocket knife carried in a closed position. As used in this section, "ordinary pocket knife" means a small knife, designed for carrying in a pocket or purse, that has its cutting edge and point entirely enclosed by its handle, and that may not be opened by a throwing, explosive, or spring action. folding knife having a blade not more than 6 inches in length.
- (e) This section does not apply if (i) the weapon is a knife, (ii) the person carrying the concealed knife is at least 18 years of age, (iii) the person carries valid identification at all times he or she is carrying a concealed knife and displays the identification upon demand by a law enforcement officer, (iv) the person has not been convicted of a felony under the laws of this State, another state, or the United States, and (v) the person is not carrying a concealed knife in or on a place where a concealed handgun is prohibited from being carried under subsection (c) of G.S. 14-415.11. For purposes of this subsection, the term "knife" means any of the following:
  - (1) A bowie knife.
- (2) A dirk.
- (3) A dagger.
  - (4) A switchblade, as that term is defined in G.S. 14-269.2.
- 24 (5) A bladed weapon of like kind to the weapons described in this subsection, but not including an ordinary pocket knife."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2025, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
