an illegal transaction as legal or a legal transaction as	79

(4) "Private seller" means a person who sells, offers for	81
sale, or transfers a firearm or ammunition and who is not a	82
federally licensed firearms dealer.	
(5) "High-capacity magazine" means an ammunition-feeding	84
device with the capacity to accept more than one hundred rounds	
of ammunition.	
Section 2. That existing section 2923.20 of the Revised	87
Code is hereby repealed.
