BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2923.251 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 2923.251. (A) The department of children and youth,	6
in conjunction with the department of public safety, shall	7
develop and provide an informational notice in English, Spanish,	8
and Arabic that contains information and best practices	9
regarding the storage of firearms. This notice shall include the	10

(1) Answers to frequently asked questions about firearm	12
<pre>storage requirements;</pre>	13
(2) Guidance on where a parent or legal guardian can	14
obtain gun locks and gun safes, including free or low-cost	15
