20	"Pistols" or "handguns" as used in the Oklahoma Firearms Act of
21	1971, Sections 1289.1 through 1289.17 of this title, shall mean any
22	firearm capable of discharging a projectile single or multiple
23	projectiles from a single round of ammunition composed of any
24	material which may reasonably be expected to be able to cause lethal

1	injury, with a barrel or barrels less than sixteen (16) inches in
2	length, and using either gunpowder, gas or any means of rocket
3	propulsion a combustible propellant charge, but not to include flare
4	guns, underwater fishing guns or blank pistols.
5	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.2, as
6	last amended by Section 2, Chapter 366, O.S.L. 2013 (21 O.S. Supp.
7	2015, Section 1290.2), is amended to read as follows:

9	DEFINITIONS
10	A. As used in the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act:
11	1. "Concealed handgun" means a loaded or unloaded pistol, the
12	presence of which is <u>or handgun</u> not openly discernible <u>visible</u> to
13	the ordinary observation of a reasonable person;
14	2. "Unconcealed handgun" means a loaded or unloaded pistol <u>or</u>
15	handgun carried upon the person in a belt holster or shoulder
16	holster that is wholly or partially where the firearm is visible, or
17	carried upon the person in <u>using</u> a scabbard, sling or case designed
18	for carrying firearms that is wholly or partially visible; and
19	3. "Pistol" <u>or "handgun"</u> means any derringer, revolver or
20	semiautomatic firearm which:
21	a. has an overall <u>barrel or barrels</u> length of less than
22	sixteen (16) inches,
23	b. is capable of discharging a projectile <u>single or</u>
24	multiple projectiles from a single round of ammunition
