DEFINITIONS

- As used in the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act:
- "Concealed handgun" means a loaded or unloaded pistol, the 1. presence of which is or handgun not openly discernible visible to the ordinary observation of a reasonable person;
- "Unconcealed handgun" or "open carry" means a loaded or 2. unloaded pistol or handgun carried upon the person in a belt holster or shoulder holster that is wholly or partially where the firearm is visible, or carried upon the person in using a scabbard, sling or case designed for carrying firearms that is wholly or partially visible; and
- 3. "Pistol" or "handgun" means any derringer, revolver or semiautomatic firearm which:
