17	Section 129. A judge of the district court, municipal judge, or
18	retired judge of the district court or retired judge of a municipal
19	<u>court</u> who receives a statement from the appropriate retirement
20	system verifying the status of the person as a retired judge of the
21	district or municipal court may carry a firearm on his or her person
22	anywhere in the state to use only for personal protection if the
23	person has successfully completed a handgun qualification course for
24	court officials developed by the Council on Law Enforcement

1	Education and Training. The Council on Law Enforcement Education
2	and Training may provide for an identification card to be issued to
3	the judge of the district court, retired judge of the district
4	court, or municipal judge or retired judge of a municipal court and
5	may provide application forms. If the person issued an
6	identification card is no longer eligible, that person shall
7	immediately return the identification card to the Council on Law
8	Enforcement Education and Training.
