20	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

23	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Second						
24	Amendment Sanctuary State Act".

1SECTION 2.NEW LAWA new section of law to be codified2in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.24e of Title 21, unless3there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Legislature hereby occupies and preempts the
entire field of legislation by the federal government, any agency of
this state or any political subdivision in this state to infringe
upon the rights of a citizen of the State of Oklahoma, the
unalienable right to keep and bear arms as guaranteed to them by the
Second Amendment of the United States Constitution.

10 Β. Any federal, state, county or municipal act, law, executive 11 order, administrative order, court order, rule, policy or regulation 12 ordering the buy-back, confiscation or surrender of firearms, 13 firearm accessories or ammunition from law-abiding citizens of this state shall be considered an infringement on the rights of citizens 14 15 to keep and bear arms as guaranteed by the Second Amendment of the Constitution of the United States and Article II, Section 26 of the 16 Constitution of Oklahoma. 17

18 C. It shall be the duty of the courts and law enforcement 19 agencies of this state to protect the rights of law-abiding citizens 20 to keep and to bear arms within the borders of this state and to 21 protect these rights from the infringement provided under the 22 provisions of this act.

23 D. The preemption provided in this act shall include:

Any regulation of arms and ammunition, pursuant to the
 National Firearms Act of 1934, prohibited or regulated on or after
 the effective date of this act; and

Any regulations or provision of the Gun Control Act of 1968,
prohibited or regulated on or after the effective date of this act.

6 E. For purposes of this section:

7 1. "Arms" is defined as any firearm, firearm part, accessory, 8 or ammunition required to render that firearm operable and 9 effective;

2. "Infringement" shall mean any law that reduces, represses,
 diminishes or subverts the right to keep and bear arms, ammunition,
 parts, and accessories in any amount that is legal as of the
 effective date of this act of any citizen in this state; and

14 3. "Law-abiding citizen" means a person who is not otherwise 15 precluded under state law from possessing a firearm and shall not be 16 construed to include anyone who is not legally present in the United 17 States or this state.

F. This act is made pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution of the United States and is therefore valid and of full effect under the supremacy clause.

21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 23 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 24 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
