14	SECOND AMENDMENT SANCTUARY STATE ACT
15	A. The State Legislature hereby occupies and preempts the
16	entire field of legislation by any agency of this state or any
17	political subdivision in this state to infringe upon the rights of a
18	citizen of the State of Oklahoma, the unalienable right to keep and
19	bear arms as guaranteed to them by the Second Amendment of the
20	United States Constitution.
21	B. Any federal, state, county or municipal act, law, executive
22	order, administrative order, court order, rule, policy or regulation
23	ordering the buy-back, confiscation or surrender of firearms,
24	firearm accessories or ammunition from law-abiding citizens of this

1 state shall be considered an infringement on the rights of citizens 2 to keep and bear arms as guaranteed by the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution of the United States and Section 26 of 3 Article II, Section 26 of the Constitution of Oklahoma Constitution. 4 5 С. It shall be the duty of the courts and law enforcement agencies of this state to protect the rights of law-abiding citizens 6 7 to keep and to bear arms within the borders of this state and to protect these rights from the infringement provided under the 8 9 provisions of this act the Second Amendment Sanctuary State Act. 10 Pursuant to the provisions of this section, a county sheriff shall 11 have the authority to detain or arrest any federal employee 12 operating within the county of the jurisdiction of the sheriff while 13 enforcing any federal act, law, executive order, administrative 14 order, court order, rule, policy, or regulation in violation of 15 subsection B of this section. 16 The preemption provided in this act the Second Amendment D. 17 Sanctuary State Act shall include: 18 Any regulation of arms and ammunition, pursuant to the 1. 19 National Firearms Act of 1934, prohibited or regulated on or after 20 the effective date of this act April 26, 2021; and 21 2. Any regulations regulation or provision of the Gun Control 22 Act of 1968, prohibited or regulated on or after the effective date 23 of this act April 26, 2021.

24 E. For purposes of this section:

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1. "Arms" is defined as shall mean any firearm, firearm part,
 2 accessory or ammunition required to render that firearm operable and
 3 effective;

2. "Infringement" shall mean any law that reduces, represses,
diminishes or subverts the right to keep and bear arms, ammunition,
parts and accessories in any amount that is legal as of the
effective date of this act <u>April 26, 2021</u>, of any citizen in this
state; and

9 3. "Law-abiding citizen" means <u>shall mean</u> a person who is not 10 otherwise precluded under state law from possessing a firearm and 11 shall not be construed to include anyone who is not legally present 12 in the United States or this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
