13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1289.13A, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1289.13A
17	IMPROPER TRANSPORTATION OF FIREARMS
18	A. Any person stopped pursuant to a moving traffic violation
19	who is transporting a firearm in or on the vehicle as authorized by
20	the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or using a valid license from another
21	state and is in violation of any law related to the carrying or
22	transporting of firearms in the vehicle, may be issued a traffic
23	citation in the amount of Seventy Dollars (\$70.00), plus court costs
24	for transporting a firearm improperly. In addition to the traffic

citation provided in this section, the person may also be arrested
 for any other violation of law.

3 B. Any firearm lawfully carried or transported as permitted4 pursuant to state law shall not be confiscated, unless:

The person is arrested for violating another provision of
 law other than a violation of subsection A of this section;
 provided, however, if the person is never charged with an offense
 pursuant to this paragraph or if the charges are dismissed or the
 person is acquitted, the weapon and ammunition shall be returned to
 the person; or

11 2. The officer has probable cause to believe the weapon is:

12 a. contraband, or

b. a firearm used in the commission of a crime other than
a violation of subsection A of this section.

15 C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require16 confiscation of any firearm.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
