16	Section 4210.3. It shall be unlawful to <del>transport a shotgun,</del>
17	<del>rifle or pistol in or to</del> discharge <del>such weapons</del> <u>a firearm</u> from a
18	vessel, except for the purposes of <u>self-defense</u> , hunting animals or
19	fowl, and in compliance with existing state and federal laws.
20	Anyone violating the provisions of this section, upon conviction,
21	shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of
22	not <del>less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not</del> more than One Hundred
23	Dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for not
24	less than ten (10) days and not more than six (6) three (3) months,

1	or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any person in possession of
2	a valid handgun license from this state or a reciprocal state
3	authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act shall not be deemed
4	guilty of transporting a pistol in violation of this section when a
5	handgun is carried concealed or unconcealed upon or about their
6	person in compliance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-
7	Defense Act.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
