12	homicide than people in other high-income countries; and
13	WHEREAS, Oklahoma averages 766 gun deaths each year, the 13th
14	highest rate in the U.S. 66% of gun deaths are from suicide; and
15	WHEREAS, protecting public safety in the communities they serve
16	is among legislators' highest responsibilities; and
17	WHEREAS, support of law-abiding citizens' Second Amendment
18	rights coincides with keeping guns from those that should not have
19	them; and
20	WHEREAS, gun violence was exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic.
21	Gun violence prevention is now more important than ever after over
22	two years of increased gun sales, calls to suicide and domestic
23	violence hotlines, and city gun violence; and

1 WHEREAS, in January 2013, Hadiya Pendleton was tragically shot 2 and killed at age 15. June 3, 2022, marked her 25th birthday and 3 people across the U.S. recognized National Gun Violence Awareness 4 Day and wore orange in tribute to Hadiya, other victims and 5 survivors of gun violence, and their loved ones; and 6 WHEREAS, the idea was inspired by Hadiya's friends and 7 classmates, who commemorated her life by wearing orange.
