- The method for replacing defective or nonfunctioning equipment; and
- A logging policy to record failures or periods when the equipment is out of service for repairs.
- C. Policies regarding the use of body cameras shall be on file at the law enforcement agency or police department and shall be open to public inspection or available on the website of the law enforcement agency or police department.
- 16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
