SENATE BILL 237 By: Paddack

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AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to school counselors; requiring school counselors to implement certain program; requiring school counselors to spend certain percentage of work time on direct services; providing description of direct services; directing school counselors to spend remainder of work time on certain services; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.528 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. School counselors shall implement a comprehensive developmental school counseling program in the schools at which they are employed. Counselors shall spend at least eighty percent (80%) of their work time providing direct services to students. Direct services shall not include the coordination of standardized testing. Direct services shall consist of:

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- 1. Delivering the school guidance curriculum through large group guidance, interdisciplinary curriculum development, group activities, and parent workshops;
- 2. Guiding individual student planning through individual or small group assistance and individual or small group advisement;
- 3. Providing responsive services through consultation with students, families, and staff; individual and small group counseling; crisis counseling; referrals; and peer facilitation; and
- 4. Performing other student services prescribed by the State Board of Education in its administrative rules.
- B. During the remainder of their work time, school counselors shall spend adequate time on school counseling program support activities that consist of professional development; consultation, collaboration, and training; and program management operations.

  School counseling program support activities shall not include the coordination of standardized testing; however, school counselors may assist other staff with the coordination of standardized testing.
- C. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.
  - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

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declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
