- B. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a violation of the Bail Enforcement and Licensing Act and shall be punished as provided in Section $\frac{3}{2}$ of this $\frac{3}{2}$ of this $\frac{3}{2}$ title.
- C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to law enforcement officers of any jurisdiction.
- D.
