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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L O	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 366, O.S.L.
L1	2016 (37A O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1-104), is amended to read as
L2	follows:
L3	Section 1-104. A. The Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement
L 4	Commission created in Section 1 of Article XXVIII of the Oklahoma
15	Constitution is hereby recreated. The purpose of the Commission
L6	shall be to enforce the alcoholic beverage laws of the State, and
L7	the Commission shall have such power and authority to enforce such
L8	laws, rules and regulations as shall be prescribed by the Oklahoma
L9	Alcoholic Beverage Control Act.
20	B. The Commission shall consist of seven (7) members, to be
21	appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the State
22	Senate; provided, members serving on the effective date of this act
23	October 1, 2017, shall continue to serve until such time as their
24	terms would have expired pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of

- 1 | Article XXVIII of the Oklahoma Constitution. Five of the members
- 2 | shall be at-large members representing the lay citizenry. The
- 3 | remaining two members shall be persons with law enforcement
- 4 experience in this state. Any time there is a vacancy on the
- 5 | Commission, the Governor shall appoint a replacement, with the
- 6 advice and consent of the State Senate, within ninety (90) days.
- 7 C. Members of the Commission shall be appointed for a term of
- 8 five (5) years.
- 9 D. No more than four members of the Commission shall be
- 10 appointed from the same political party. No more than two members
- 11 of the Commission shall be appointed from the same federal
- 12 | congressional district.
- 13 E. No member of the Commission shall hold any license
- 14 | authorized by the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act, or have
- 15 any interest in any capacity, in the manufacture, sale, distribution
- 16 or transportation of alcoholic beverages.
- 17 F. The members of the Commission shall be removable from office
- 18 | for cause as other officers not subject to impeachment.
- G. The Commission shall appoint a Director, whose duties shall
- 20 be defined as provided in Section \$ 1-108 of this act title.
- 21 H. The State of Oklahoma shall take all necessary steps to
- 22 ensure the timely implementation of Enrolled Senate Joint Resolution
- 23 No. 68 of the 2nd Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, if
- 24 approved by the voters. Consistent with this objective, the ABLE

1 Commission shall have the power to issue interim licenses prior to 2 October 1, 2018, as follows:

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- 1. Except for the sale of wine or beer to the public, an interim license shall allow all qualified retail wine and retail beer licensees to perform all activities permissible under a full license including but not limited to purchasing, stocking and storing the wine and/or full-strength beer prior to October 1, 2018. In order to qualify for an interim license, the licensee must satisfy all the requirements set forth in Article XXVIIIA of the Oklahoma Constitution and this act. The interim license shall convert to a full license on October 1, 2018;
- 2. Package stores may install refrigerated coolers for the storage of beer and wine prior to October 1, 2018, provided the refrigerated coolers shall not be used to cool product below room temperature until on or after October 1, 2018; and
- 3. An interim license shall allow all qualified wine and 16 spirits wholesalers and beer distributors to perform all activities 17 permissible under a full license including but not limited to 18 selling and delivering wine and/or full-strength beer to all 19 qualified retail wine and retail beer licensees. In order to 20 qualify for an interim license, the wine and spirits wholesaler and 21 beer distributor must comply with the provisions set forth in 22 Article XXVIIIA of the Oklahoma Constitution and this act. The 23 interim license shall convert to a full license on October 1, 2018. 24

1	I. No retail wine or retail beer licensee may sell wine and/or
2	beer, other than low-point beer, and no package store may sell
3	refrigerated wine and/or beer, prior to October 1, 2018. The sale
4	or refrigeration of wine and/or beer in violation of this subsection
5	shall result in the revocation of the interim license and a monetary
6	fine of Twenty-five Thousand dollars (\$25,000.00).
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 2017.
