11 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to school security; requiring school  
13 districts to undergo certain assessment by certain  
14 date; requiring the assessment to include certain  
15 recommendations; providing an exemption; directing  
16 school districts to conduct re-assessments; amending  
17 74 O.S. 2021, Section 51.2b, as amended by Section 5,  
18 Chapter 302, O.S.L. 2022 (74 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section  
19 51.2b), which relates to the Oklahoma School Security  
20 Grant Program Act; providing eligibility criteria for  
21 grant awards; clarifying eligible grant fund  
22 expenditures; directing annual report to include  
23 certain information; providing for codification;  
24 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-148.1 of Title 70, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1       A. Except as provided for in subsection B of this section, by  
2 July 1, 2026, each school district in this state shall undergo a  
3 risk and vulnerability assessment conducted by the Oklahoma School  
4 Security Institute or a nationally qualified risk and vulnerability  
5 assessor. The assessment shall include recommendations to increase  
6 security on school district property.

7       B. A school district that completed a risk and vulnerability  
8 assessment conducted by the Oklahoma School Security Institute or a  
9 nationally qualified risk and vulnerability assessor in the two (2)  
10 years prior to the effective date of this act shall be exempt from  
11 the provisions of subsection A of this section.

12       C. After an initial risk and vulnerability assessment is  
13 conducted, school districts shall conduct re-assessments every five  
14 (5) years.

15       SECTION 2.       AMENDATORY       74 O.S. 2021, Section 51.2b, as  
16 amended by Section 5, Chapter 302, O.S.L. 2022 (74 O.S. Supp. 2022,  
17 Section 51.2b), is amended to read as follows:

18       Section 51.2b A. This section shall be known and may be cited  
19 as the "Oklahoma School Security Grant Program Act".

20       B. The Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management shall  
21 solicit proposals for and make grants for the enhancement of campus  
22 security at institutions of higher learning, technology center  
23 schools, public schools, and private schools.

1 C. The goals and objectives of the Oklahoma School Security  
2 Grant Program are to:

3 1. Increase the awareness of the public and educational  
4 institutions of the risks, threats, and vulnerabilities of school  
5 campuses as well as mitigation strategies;

6 2. Incentivize participation in school security training  
7 programs designed to assess campus risks, threats, and  
8 vulnerabilities;

9 3. Provide assistance to institutions of higher learning,  
10 technology center schools, public schools, and private schools  
11 initiating or implementing school security plans, programs, and  
12 activities; and

13 4. Build upon the success of the pilot Education Grant Program  
14 established by the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security.

15 D. The Department shall determine grant project criteria and  
16 establish a process for the consideration of proposals. The  
17 proposals shall be considered on a statewide competitive basis among  
18 peer institutions. To be eligible for an Oklahoma School Security  
19 Grant Program award, an institution of higher learning, technology  
20 center school, public school, or private school shall:

21 1. Complete a risk and vulnerability assessment conducted by  
22 the Oklahoma School Security Institute or a nationally qualified  
23 risk and vulnerability assessor; and

1        2. Agree to expend grant funds on items recommended by the risk  
2 and vulnerability assessment and/or to provide de-escalation and  
3 behavioral threat assessment and management training to employees.  
4 Recommended items eligible for grant fund expenditures may include,  
5 but shall not be limited to, physical security enhancements such as  
6 cameras, gates, lighting, locks, doors, windows, security  
7 geofencing, and ballistic storm shelters.

8        E. On or before January 1, 2010, and each year thereafter, the  
9 Department shall prepare an annual report on the Oklahoma School  
10 Security Grant Program and submit the report to the Governor, the  
11 President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, and the Speaker  
12 of the Oklahoma House of Representatives. The report shall include  
13 a list of the recipients of Oklahoma School Security Grant Program  
14 awards and information on how grant funds were used during the  
15 previous year.

16        SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

17        SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
18 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby  
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
