9 Section 1290.6, which relates to the Oklahoma Self-
10 Defense Act; modifying scope of certain unlawful act;
removing administrative penalty; and providing an
effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.6, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1290.6.

17 PROHIBITED AMMUNITION

18 Any concealed or unconcealed handgun when carried in a manner
19 authorized by the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and
20 when loaded with any ammunition which is ~~either~~ a restricted bullet
21 as defined by Section 1289.19 of this title ~~or is larger than .45~~
22 ~~caliber~~ or is otherwise prohibited by law shall be deemed a
23 prohibited weapon for purposes of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.

24 Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be

1 punished for a criminal offense as provided by Section 1272 of this
2 title or any other applicable provision of law. ~~In addition to any~~
3 ~~criminal prosecution for a violation of the provisions of this~~
4 ~~section, the licensee shall be subject to an administrative fine of~~
5 ~~Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), upon a hearing and determination by~~
6 ~~the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation that the person is in~~
7 ~~violation of the provisions of this section.~~

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
