- "SECTION 26. No later than December 1, 2024, the Department of 4 Human Services shall report to the interim committees of the Legis-5 lative Assembly related to human services, in the manner provided in 6 ORS 192.245:
- "(1) The department's progress in planning for the elimination of 8
  - civil commitment of individuals based on intellectual disabilities; and
  - "(2) Recommendations for budget or policy actions necessary to ensure that individuals with intellectual disabilities who have exceptionally high needs are ensured continued access to appropriate services and supports.
- "SECTION 27. The amendments to ORS 181A.290 by section 13 of 14 this 2024 Act do not apply to an individual whose information was, 15 prior to the operative date specified in section 29 of this 2024 Act, 16 transmitted to the Department of State Police as a result of the indi-17 vidual being committed by a court to the custody of the Department 18 of Human Services under ORS 427.290, as in effect prior to the opera-19 tive date specified in section 29 of this 2024 Act, based on a finding that 20 the individual was dangerous to self or others. 21

"SECTION 28. Section 26 of this 2024 Act is repealed on January 2, 1 2025. 2

"SECTION 29. (1) Section 2 of this 2024 Act, the amendments to 3 statutes by sections 3 to 25 of this 2024 Act and the repeal of statutes by section 1 of this 2024 Act become operative on July 1, 2025.

"(2) The Department of Human Services may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the department to carry out section 26 of this 2024 Act and to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by the amendments to statutes by sections 3 to 25 of this 2024 Act.

"SECTION 30. This 2024 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2024 Act takes effect on its passage.".
