

House Bill 2173

Sponsored by Representative STARK (at the request of James Klein) (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows person harmed by criminal act resulting in physical injury or death to bring action for damages against place of public accommodation if place of public accommodation prohibits visitors from possessing firearm.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to liability of places of public accommodation.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "place of public accommodation" has the meaning**
5 **given that term in ORS 659A.400.**

6 **(2) A person harmed by a criminal act in a place of public accommodation resulting in**
7 **death or physical injury or serious physical injury, as defined in ORS 161.015, may bring an**
8 **action for damages against the place of public accommodation if the place of public accom-**
9 **modation prohibits visitors from possessing a firearm in the place of public accommodation.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act applies only to criminal acts occurring on or after**
11 **the effective date of this 2017 Act.**
