

Senate Bill 495

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes county to regulate purchase of used firearms by pawnshops and secondhand stores.

2 Relating to county regulation of the purchase of used merchandise; amending ORS 166.175.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 166.175 is amended to read:

5 166.175. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a city **or county** may [*continue to*]
6 regulate the purchase of used firearms by pawnshops and secondhand stores.

7 (2) As used in this section, "secondhand store" means a store or business whose primary source
8 of revenue is the sale of used merchandise.
