

# Senate Bill 764

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of State Police to study reasons for certain denials of concealed handgun license applications and report results to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before February 1, 2019.

Sunsets January 2, 2020.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to firearms.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of State Police shall study the reasons for the denials under**  
5 **ORS 166.293 of concealed handgun license applications between January 1, 2008, and January**  
6 **1, 2018, and present the results of the study in a report to the interim committees of the**  
7 **Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on**  
8 **or before February 1, 2019.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2020.**
