## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the 70th anniversary of "V-J Day," the official end 2 of World War II, on September 2, 2015.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Pacific War, sometimes called the Asia-Pacific
- 4 War, was the theater of World War II which was fought in the
- 5 Pacific and East Asia between the Allied powers and the Empire
- 6 of Japan; and
- 7 WHEREAS, It is generally considered that the Pacific War
- 8 began on December 7, 1941, when Japan invaded Thailand and
- 9 attacked the British possessions of Malaya, Singapore and Hong
- 10 Kong as well as the United States military bases in Hawaii and
- 11 the Philippines; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The war culminated in the atomic bombings of
- 13 Hiroshima and Nagasaki, and other large aerial bomb attacks by
- 14 the United States Army Air Forces, accompanied by the Soviet
- 15 invasion of Manchuria on August 8, 1945, resulting in the
- 16 Japanese announcement of intent to surrender on August 15, 1945;
- 17 and
- 18 WHEREAS, On August 14, 1945, President Truman announced to

- 1 the American people the news of the pending Japanese surrender
- 2 and the occasion was declared "Victory Over Japan Day" or "V-J
- 3 Day"; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The formal and official surrender of Japan took
- 5 place aboard the battleship USS Missouri in Tokyo Bay on
- 6 September 2, 1945; and
- 7 WHEREAS, More than 250 Allied warships lay at anchor in Tokyo
- 8 Bay during the event; and
- 9 WHEREAS, General Douglas MacArthur, appointed by President
- 10 Truman to head the Allied occupation of Japan as Supreme
- 11 Commander of the Allied Powers, presided over and accepted the
- 12 surrender by the representative of the Japanese government; and
- WHEREAS, More than 405,000 American soldiers died and 670,000
- 14 were wounded during World War II; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the 70th anniversary of
- 16 "V-J Day," the official end of World War II, on September 2,
- 17 2015.
