It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 11-47 of the General Laws entitled "Weapons" is hereby amended
by adding thereto the following section:

11-47-63. Prohibition of possession of explosive materials. – (a) Any person who is
prohibited from possessing a firearm shall be prohibited from the possession of explosive

5 materials as defined in 27 CFR 555.23 – List of explosive materials. Any license or permit, issued

6 to a person so prohibited to conduct blasting operations or conduct displays of fireworks or

7 <u>pyrotechnics shall be immediately revoked or suspended for the duration of the prohibition to</u>

8 possess firearms.

9 (b) Every person who violates the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be
10 punished by imprisonment of not more than five (5) years, or a fine of not more than five

11 <u>thousand dollars (\$5,000), or both.</u>

12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
