It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows：

SECTION 1．Chapter 11－47 of the General Laws entitled＂Weapons＂is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section：

11－47－35．4．Sale or transfer to a party who is not intended owner or possessor．
（a）No person shall knowingly purchase or otherwise obtain a firearm on behalf of or transfer to a person who the transferor knows or reasonably should know is prohibited from possessing or receiving a firearm under federal or state law．
（b）Every person violating this section shall be，upon conviction，subject to imprisonment for up to ten（10）years，a fine up to ten thousand dollars $(\$ 10,000)$ ，or both．Any person violating $\underline{\text { this section upon a second or subsequent conviction shall be subject to imprisonment for not less }}$ than two（2）years nor more than fifteen（15）years，a fine up to fifteen thousand dollars $(\$ 15,000)$ ，or both．Except for a first conviction under this section，the person shall not be afforded the provisions of suspension or deferment of sentence，nor probation．

SECTION 2．This act shall take effect upon passage．
