It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-47-23 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-47 entitled "Weapons" 2 is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 11-47-23. False information in securing firearm or license False information in 4 securing firearm or license - Straw purchases. 5 (a) No person shall, in purchasing or otherwise securing delivery of a shotgun, rifle, pistol, or revolver firearm, or in applying for a license or permit to carry it, give false information or offer 6 7 false evidence of his or her identity. Violation of the provisions of this section may be punished by a fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000), imprisonment for not more than five (5) 8 9 years, or both. 10 (b) No person shall knowingly purchase or otherwise obtain a firearm on behalf of another 11 person, or transfer a firearm to another person, whom the transferor knows or reasonably should 12 know is prohibited from possessing a firearm under federal or state law. 13 (c) A first violation of the provisions of this section may be punished by a fine of not more 14 than five thousand dollars (\$5,000), imprisonment for not more than five (5) years, or both. A 15 second and subsequent violation of the provisions of this section may be punished by a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), imprisonment for not more than ten (10) years, or both. 16

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

purchase of firearms by use of false information.
