- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the carrying of certain
- 2 guns on certain premises.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-32-7 be amended to read:
- 5 13-32-7. Any person, other than a law enforcement officer or school sentinel acting pursuant
- 6 to under § 13-64-1, who intentionally carries, has in his possession possesses, stores, keeps,
- 7 leaves, places, or puts into the possession of another person, any <u>dangerous weapon</u>, firearm,
- 8 or air gun, whether or not the firearm or air gun is designed, adapted, used, or intended to be
- 9 used primarily for imitative or noisemaking purposes, or any dangerous weapon, on or in any
- 10 public elementary or secondary school premises, vehicle, or building, or on or in any premises,
- vehicle, or building used or leased for <u>public</u> elementary or secondary school functions, whether
- or not any person is endangered by such actions any action under this section, is guilty of a Class
- 13 1 misdemeanor. This The provisions of this section does do not apply to starting guns while in
- 14 use;

1	<u>(1)</u>	Use of a starting gun at an athletic events, firearms, or air guns at firing ranges, gun
2		shows, and supervised schools or sessions for training in the use of firearms. This
3		section does not apply to the ceremonial event:
4	<u>(2)</u>	Any firearm or air gun at a:
5		(a) Firing range;
6		(b) Gun show;
7		(c) Supervised school or session for training in the use of firearms; or
8		(d) <u>Ceremonial</u> presence of unloaded weapons at color guard ceremonies;
9	<u>(3)</u>	Any nonpublic school;
10	<u>(4)</u>	Any church or other house of worship; or
11	<u>(5)</u>	Any nonpublic school located on the premises of a church or other house of worship.
